VINE **ATTRIBUTES**

Vigorous variety **Buds early** Ripens late and unevenly Sensitive to spring frost, Prone to powdery mildew, grey rot, eutypa die back

WESTEIERMARK MATCHING

The schist and gneiss could limit its vigour. A variety that buds early would be prone to the spring frosts of the area and the fact that it ripens late would mean that it may fail to ripen well. One could maybe try to make a sparkling wine.
