## WINE STYLES

Produces wine with a wide range from dry to sweet and shows it's best in a cool continental climate. It is a late ripening variety shows primary fruity aromas on the nose such as lemon, lime, nectarine and on the palate high acidity with low alcohol. Some examples of Riesling are capable of ageing in bottle for decades, in this case the primary fruit aromas turn into smoke, honey and sometimes petrol.

## WESTIERMARK MATCHING

We would be able to plant Riesling only on our cooler sites of our vineyard. The hours of sunshine would be limited with canopy management in order to protect the grapes from too much sun, especially in the afternoon hours. Our altitude would preserve the Riesling's acidity.
