Considering the free-draining soils and long hours of exposition to sunshine of the cold climate of Weststeiermark, Viognier – being an early ripening grape - could ripen successfully. It however needs enough warmth to express its aromas fully and have enough sugar accumulation, therefore, winegrowers might struggle in the coldest years.
